I am delighted to share with you the 2020 National Senior Certificate results. The Grade 12s have done themselves and the school proud, and we congratulate all of them on their results.

Our 80 girls achieved a 100% pass rate with **ALL** girls achieving a **Bachelor Degree Pass**; and a total of 256 distinctions; 29 girls achieved 4 or more distinctions, with the average for the Grade of 3.2 distinctions per girl and 77.2% for the Grade. 79% of all marks were above 70%, and 93% of all marks were above 60%. Our girls achieved 17 positions in the top 1% of candidates per subject nationally.
