Application Fee

A non-refundable application fee of R600 per application is payable when an application form is submitted.

Application Documents

The application form must be accompanied by a copy of the applicant's latest school report and proof of payment of the application fee. All documents may be scanned and emailed to admissions@twc.org.za or delivered to the school.

Admission Interview & Assessment

Before an offer of a place can be made, the applicant is required to attend an admission interview with the Lady Principal or the Headmistress of the Junior School. No girl is admitted to The Wykeham Collegiate without an interview. All girls are also required to be assessed in a manner appropriate to their age (oral/written/both).

Admission Information

When a girl is offered a place by the school, a non-refundable admission fee, equivalent to a month's fees (boarding and tuition for boarders) becomes payable.

Parents who reside outside of South Africa are required to make an additional deposit equivalent to one term's boarding and tuition fee, and this will increase on an annual basis to match the termly school fee for the current year. The deposit will be offset against the balance of the girl's final account from the school.

Parent Contract

The proof of deposit must accompany the Parent Contract, which is required to be signed by both parents and/or guardians, or, in the case of one parent/guardian, that parent and an acceptable surety. The signatories are to be witnessed.

Confirmation of Place

Once the proof of payment of the admission fee and the correctly completed Parent Contract have been received, the school will be able to formally confirm placement.

Sibling Rebate

The **Sibling Rebate** amounts to a 10% discount off the tuition fees of the younger sibling/s where two or more girls from the same family currently attend TWC. However, the rebate will not apply in respect of girls who are already receiving financial assistance. Please note that the Development Levy will be payable in respect of each girl attending the school, regardless of whether the girl has siblings at TWC or not.

Transport & Bus Service

The Wykeham Collegiate runs a bus service from Howick and Hilton to the school campus on all school day mornings. In addition, there are buses for boarders to Durban North and Ballito on weekends in term time. Please contact the school for more information regarding cost and availability of space on the bus.

Bursaries (Grades 8 – 12)

Limited funds are available in the event of a girl requiring assistance. Parents requesting consideration for a bursary will be asked to complete a bursary application form to provide a confidential motivation. Applications must be submitted by the start of the second term for the following academic year.
