Dear TWC Community

I am delighted to share with you the 2025 National Senior Certificate results. The Grade 12s have done themselves and the school proud, and we congratulate all of them on their results.

Our girls achieved a 100% pass rate with **ALL** girls achieving a **Bachelor Degree pass**. It is not only about our top achievers, but about each individual realising their potential. 78.5% of all marks were above 70%, and 92% of all marks were above 60%.

As a point of interest: This is the first cohort of girls who did not write entrance exams for entry into Grade 8 and did not receive scholarships. The results they have achieved are the best overall results since the start of The Wykeham Collegiate in 1990, with 49% of the girls achieving 4 or more distinctions out of a possible 7.

Our girls achieved **9** positions in the top 1% of candidates per subject nationally.

Juwayriya Siddique and Lia Stravino were acknowledged on the **IEB Commendable Achievement** list for achieving a ranking within the top 5% of all IEB learners in **5** of the NSC subjects they offered and scoring 80% or more for Life Orientation.
